



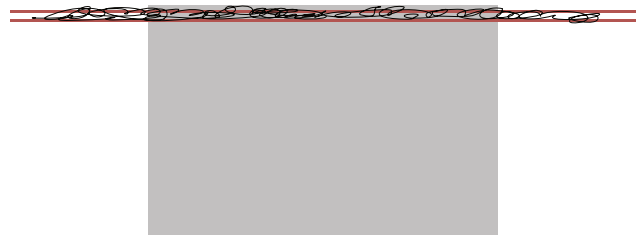
# 5 OUT OF 4 PATTERNS

## Sewing School: Gathering Serger Technique

Disclaimer: I use a Brother 1034D and have made my adjustment based on my machine. As each machine is unique you may need to make other adjustments to your setting. Be sure to test on a scrap piece of fabric until your setting give the desired results.

1. Adjust stitch length to 4 and differential feed to 2 and disengage the knife. As an extra option to make seeing the needle threads easier you may choose a different color thread in the needles.

2. Stitch along fabric to be gathered being sure to leave long tails on either end.



3. Separate needle threads tails from looper threads. Begin gathering by pushing fabric down the threads. Take your time and spread them evenly. Once you've reached about halfway start from the other side. Spread the fabric evenly across the threads.
